

Standards of Business Conduct Annual Report 2019/20

1. Introduction

- 1.1 A full revision of the Standards of Business Conduct (the Standards) was undertaken during 2018 in order to incorporate legal advice and NHS England's (NHSE) Conflicts of Interest statutory guidance applicable to NHS foundation trusts published in February 2017, and NHSE's model conflicts of interest policy published in March 2017.
- The revised Standards were approved by the Board of Directors in December 2018 at which point Board members requested that the length of the main document was shortened prior to its dissemination across the Trust. The Standards were further revised and the length of the main document (excluding appendices) was reduced from 43 pages to 12.
- 1.3 The revised and shortened Standards were approved by the Board of Directors at its 28 May 2019 meeting and were disseminated across the Trust via Team Brief on 04 June 2019.
- 1.4 During 2019/20 the focus has continued to be on ensuring all colleagues understand their obligations to adhere to the Standards as well as their obligations under NHSE's Conflicts of Interest guidance. A proactive exercise undertaken jointly by the Head of Governance and the Counter Fraud Specialist during 2019/20 focussed on the Consultant body as well as medical secretaries.

2. Background

- 2.1 The Standards outline the principles by which decisions are made by the Trust, its management and staff and through which they can be held accountable. Best practice guidance for business activities is included within the Standards in addition to advice as to how colleagues may raise concerns, and how such concerns will be dealt with, if an individual believes these practices are not being followed.
- 2.2 Specific guidance is provided for the declaration of gifts, benefits, hospitability or sponsorship, all of which should be declared and registered if they amount to more than £25. Gifts must also be declared if several small gifts from the same, or closely related source, total more than £50 in a 12-month period.
- 2.3 A strong corporate responsibility programme is engendered throughout the organisation through adherence to the Standards, which ensures that the Trust's business remains well within legal requirements. All employees are able to feel confident about the Trust's standards of business practice because their working environment is geared towards adherence to the Standards. The Standards enable the Trust to continue to achieve financial and operating results whilst adhering to high ethical standards which guide relationships with service users, employees, external partners and local communities.
- 2.4 Effective communication of the Standards throughout the organisation ensures that all colleagues understand their responsibilities in relation to the Standards of Business Conduct and related policies and procedures and is crucial to the adherence to, and compliance with, ethical business practices (and as a result, the relevant legislation and regulation). During 2019/20 the Head of Governance continued to lead an awareness raising campaign

designed to ensure all colleagues are aware of the Standards and their obligations under NHSE's Conflicts of Interest guidance. Table 1 highlights the awareness campaign during 2019/20.

- 2.5 During 2019/20 the Head of Governance continued to lead an awareness raising programme across the Trust in relation to NHSE's Conflicts of Interest guidance and the Standards. This included:
 - A section on the May and June 2019 Team Brief sessions
 - Articles in the 'all users' Communications messages in April, July, November and December 2019
 - Targeted requests for declarations of interest to be made by Consultants circulated by the Medical Director in October, November 2019 and March 2020
 - Separate targeted requests for declarations of interest from secretaries undertaking private work for Consultants during December 2019
- In addition, the Standards of Business Conduct and Conflict of Interest webpages on The Hub were updated during 2019/20 to ensure ease of access for all colleagues to the shortened Standards and the appendices containing the two different declaration forms. In addition, bespoke meetings and training sessions were also provided when requested by various Divisions and services.

3. Overview of Achievements during the period 2019/20

3.1 The main achievements during 2019/20 were the approval of the revised and shortened Standards of Business Conduct in May 2019; the fact that no breaches of the Standards were reported during the year and the significant increase in the numbers of declarations of interest received compared to 2018/19.

- 3.2 The Company Secretary and the Head of Governance were contacted during the year on numerous occasions for advice by colleagues from a variety of professional groups.
 - 83 declarations were made during 2019/20 for gifts, benefits, hospitability or sponsorship using the Standards of Business conduct declaration form. Of these 8 were declined (either by staff member themselves or by Head of Governance), 2 were partially approved (some of the items offered were accepted whilst others were declined), 67 were approved and 6 were retrospective notifications. This represents a decrease of 2 declarations compared to 2018/19. For further details, please see appendix 1.
 - 168 declarations of interest were made relating to the 2019/20 financial year and were added to the Register of Staff Interests. This represents an increase of 111 declarations of interest compared to 2018/19 and is largely due to the proactive exercises undertaken during the year.
 - The Trust continued to meet the NHS England deadlines for the publication of the Register of Staff Interests on its internet site. For further details, please see appendix 2.
 - The Post Graduate Medical Education department (PGME) recorded that 25 occasions of funding were received during 2019/20 for the PGME Tuesday lunchtime lecture programme (compared to 11 occasions during 2018/19), see appendix 3.
 - PGME recorded sponsorship of lunches on 25 occasions (an increase of 7 from 2018/19) from companies for the weekly Acute Medicine Teaching Programme, see appendix 4.
 - PGME recorded sponsorship of lunches on 36 occasions (a reduction of 1 from 2018/19) from companies for the weekly Grand Rounds Teaching Programme, see appendix 5.

3.3 All new employee contracts include a reference to the Standards i.e.:

Standards of business conduct

You have a responsibility to declare any private interest which conflicts, or appears to conflict, with your NHS duties. Where appropriate to your job you are required to comply with the Standards of Business Conduct for NHS Staff (HSG(93)5), a copy of which is available from the Department of Health Website www.dh.gov.uk or the Human Resources Department.

The Trust operates a zero-tolerance approach to bribery and corruption. It is a condition of your continued employment with the Trust that you comply with all applicable legal requirements relating to anti-bribery and anti-corruption including the Bribery Act 2010. Your employment will be summarily terminated in the event that you are found to have failed to comply with the requirements of the Bribery Act 2010.

In addition, a member of the Recruitment Team goes through the Declaration of Interests form for each candidate during their Recruitment Clinic Appointment to ensure that all prospective new colleagues declare any material interests before their appointment.

- Those colleagues involved in procurement at the Trust are provided with advice to ensure they act in accordance with the Supplies Code of Conduct regarding their receipt of incentives e.g. loyalty points, colleagues' contact with company representatives etc. This advice is formalised through the inclusion of guidance within the Trust's 'Policy and Guidance for the Procurement of Goods, Services and Works (Procurement Policy)'.
- 3.5 As evidenced in table 1 above, the Head of Governance and the Communications Team have continued to work jointly during the year to maintain a Trust-wide communications plan to publicise both the Standards and NHS England's Conflicts of Interest guidance. The plan included (but was not limited to):
 - Refresh of the dedicated intranet pages for Standards of Business Conduct and Declaration of Interests
 - Circulation of 'all e-mail user' communications relating to Standards of Business Conduct declarations and addressing the appropriate way to donate to the Rotherham Hospital and Community Charity
 - Reminders to all staff to complete declaration of interest forms if applicable
 - Screensavers relating to the Standards of Business Conduct continued to be used

4. The Way Forward for 2020/21

4.1. Roll out of the new Conflicts of Interest module on the Electronic Staff Record (ESR) which will enable all colleagues to declare their interests online rather than using hard copy forms. By using ESR it will be much easier to target those colleagues at Bands 8D and above to notify them of the need to make a declaration of interest or a nil return every year and the system will automatically send reminders to these colleagues until they have undertaken this action. The system will also facilitate clinical colleagues to declare their private practice. The roll out was scheduled for April 2020, however it was delayed due to COVID-19 and will be rolled out as soon as possible in 2020.

- 4.2 Following the approval of the revised and shortened Standards, the awareness raising programme will continue during 2020/21.
- 4.3 Targeted training will continue to be undertaken by the Head of Governance in conjunction with the Counter Fraud Specialist to address areas of the Trust where declarations of interest could be increased.
- 4.4 All Trust policies are required to identify how adherence to the policy will be monitored and this includes those policies referenced within the Standards. The work of the Counter Fraud Specialist and Internal Audit are complementary to the Trust's own work programme to promote adherence by all colleagues to these Standards.

5. Breaches of NHS England's Conflicts of Interest Guidance

5.1 NHS England's Managing Conflicts of Interest guidance which came into force in June 2017 notes that:

'There will be situations when interests will not be identified, declared or managed appropriately and effectively. This may happen innocently, accidentally, or because of the deliberate actions of staff or organisations. For the purposes of this guidance these situations are referred to as 'breaches'.

The guidance recommends that a report on such breaches is received by the governing body, Audit Committee or Executive Team on a regular basis to ensure that lessons are learnt and that the management of interests continually improves. The Trust's Standards of Business Conduct state that the Audit Committee will receive such breach reports on at least a six-monthly basis. The most recent such report was received by the Audit Committee in May 2020.

During 2019/20 zero breaches were reported to the Company Secretary, Head of Governance or Counter Fraud Specialist.

6. Conclusion

Overall the impact of the Standards on the declaration of gifts, benefits, hospitality, sponsorship and interests has been positive as evidenced by the number of declarations made, and enquires received, relating to the both the Standards and conflicts of interest in year. As mentioned above, the Standards are underpinned by several Trust policies therefore publication of articles explaining the relevance of the policies to the Standards serve to enhance colleague awareness and increase understanding.

7. Action required by the Audit Committee

- 7.1 The Audit Committee is invited to:
 - Approve this annual report and support the further work to be undertaken to safeguard ethical business practice in the future.
